YOU WILL NEED:

1 Lg Cardboard Box • Cardboard Scraps • Markers • Glue • Scissors • Paper Plates • Printable Car Templates

Print car templates and color them in.

Take large cardboard box with opening facing up & 2 smaller scraps to glue onto it, creating front & back of car. OPTIONAL: Wrap car in old wrapping paper for polished look.

Glue steering wheel, speedometer & rearview mirrors to paper plate & cut, ensuring you leave a tab to glue it to the car base.

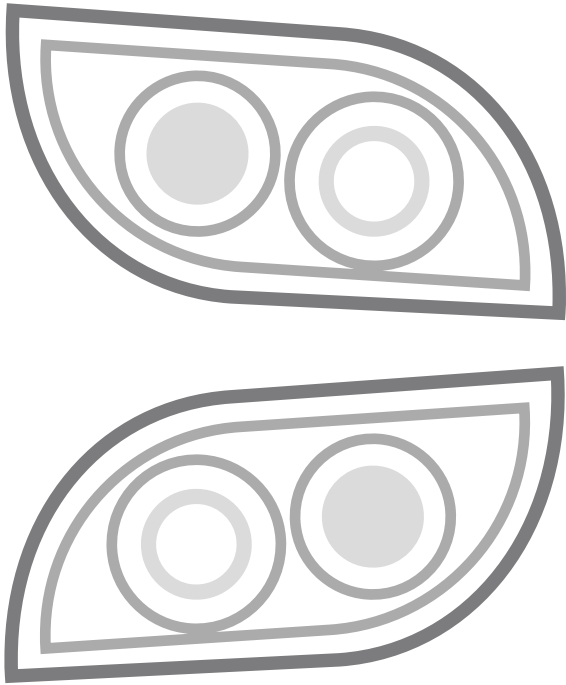
Glue pedals to scrap cardboard and slip into the front of the car's foot area. Glue all other accessories on as well. Now, you're ready to zoom to the drive-in movie!

FUN FACT:

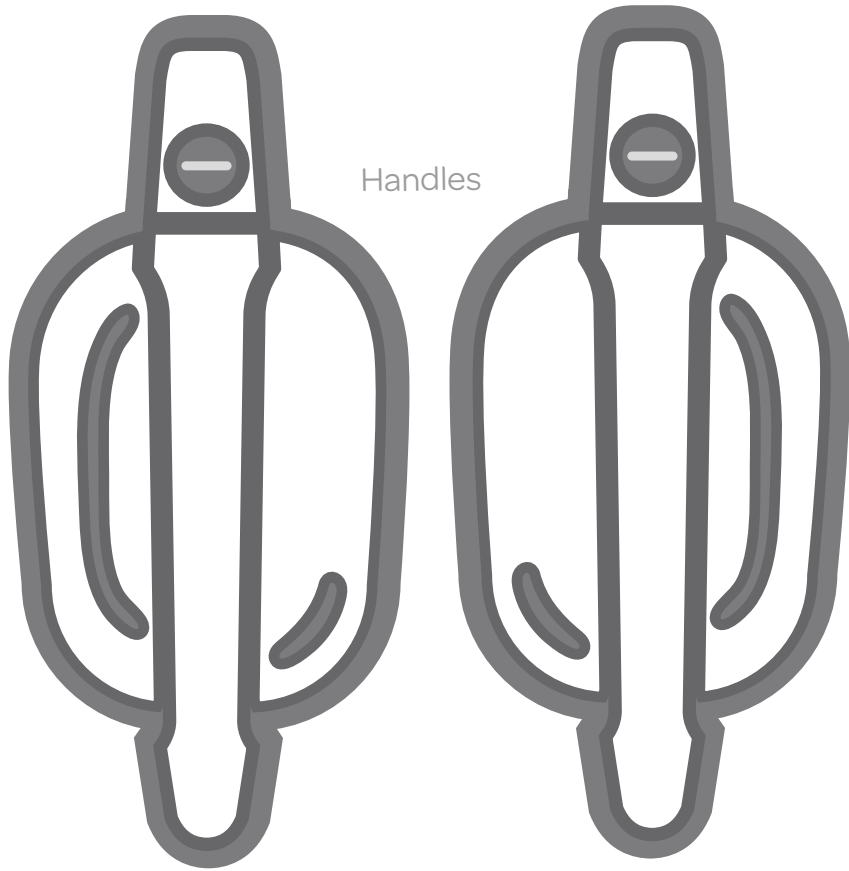
On June 6, 1933, excited motorists park their cars at the first-ever drive-in movie theater, located on Crescent Boulevard in Camden, NJ.



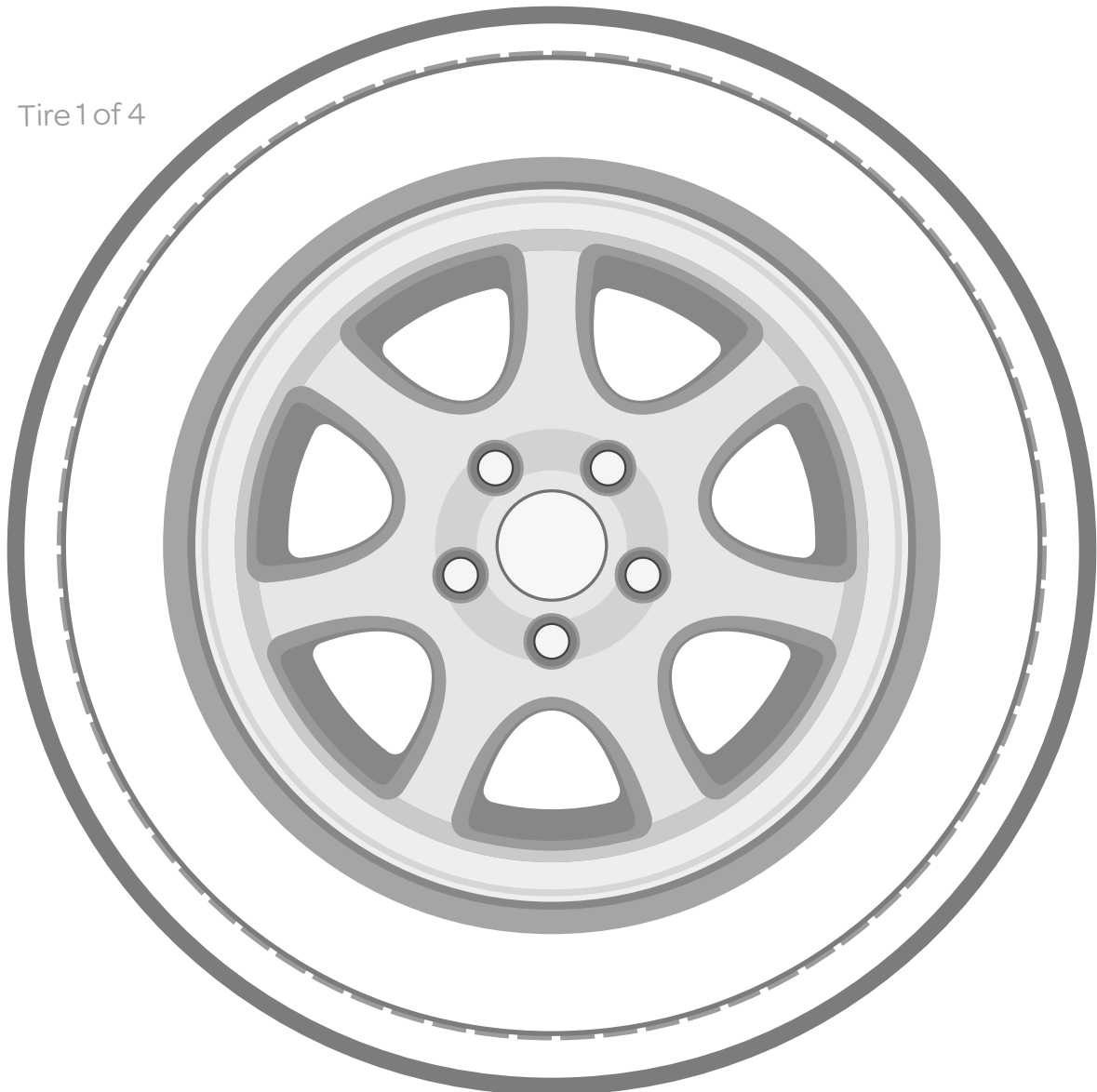
