First up:

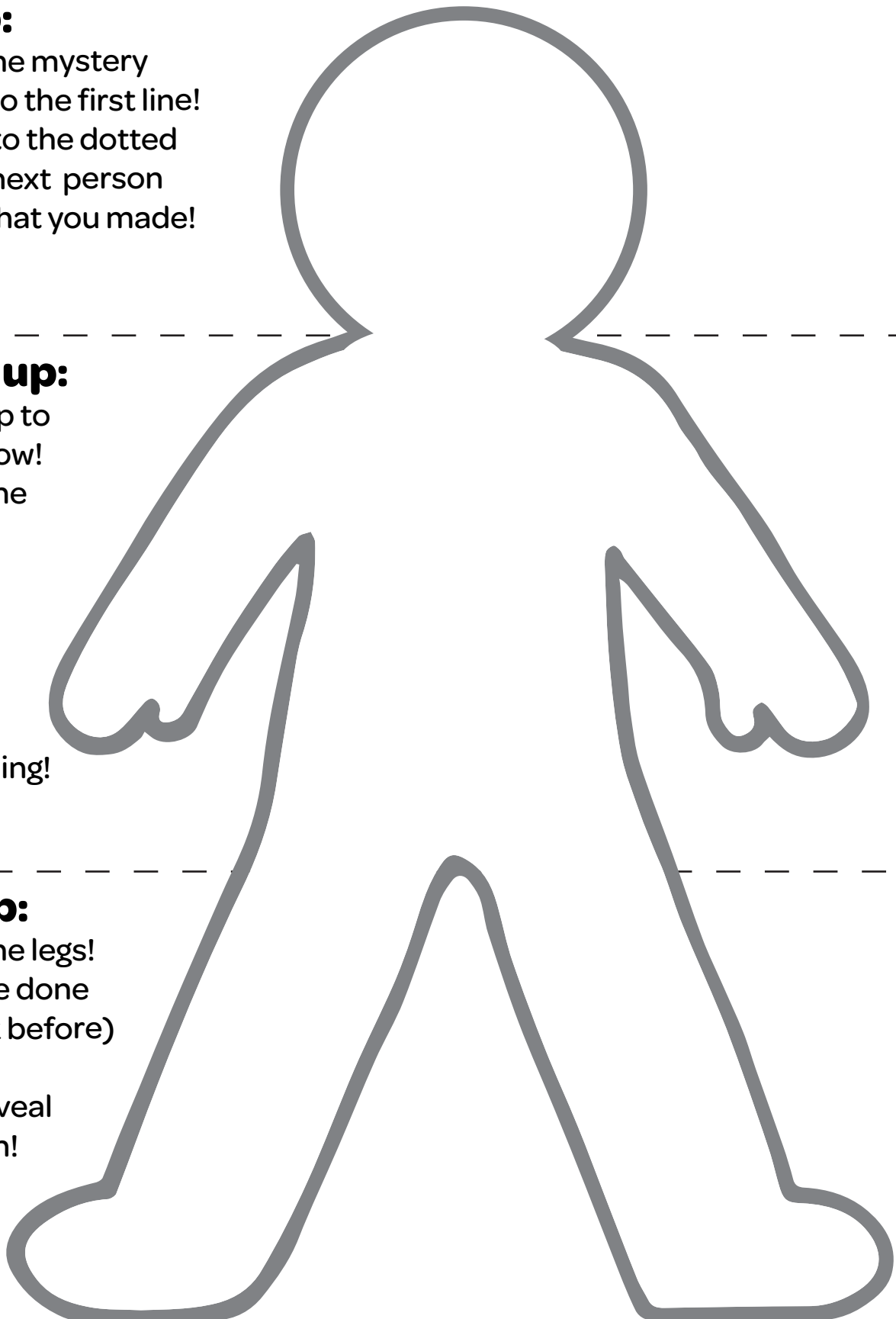
Decorate the mystery person up to the first line!
Fold down to the dotted line so the next person can't see what you made!

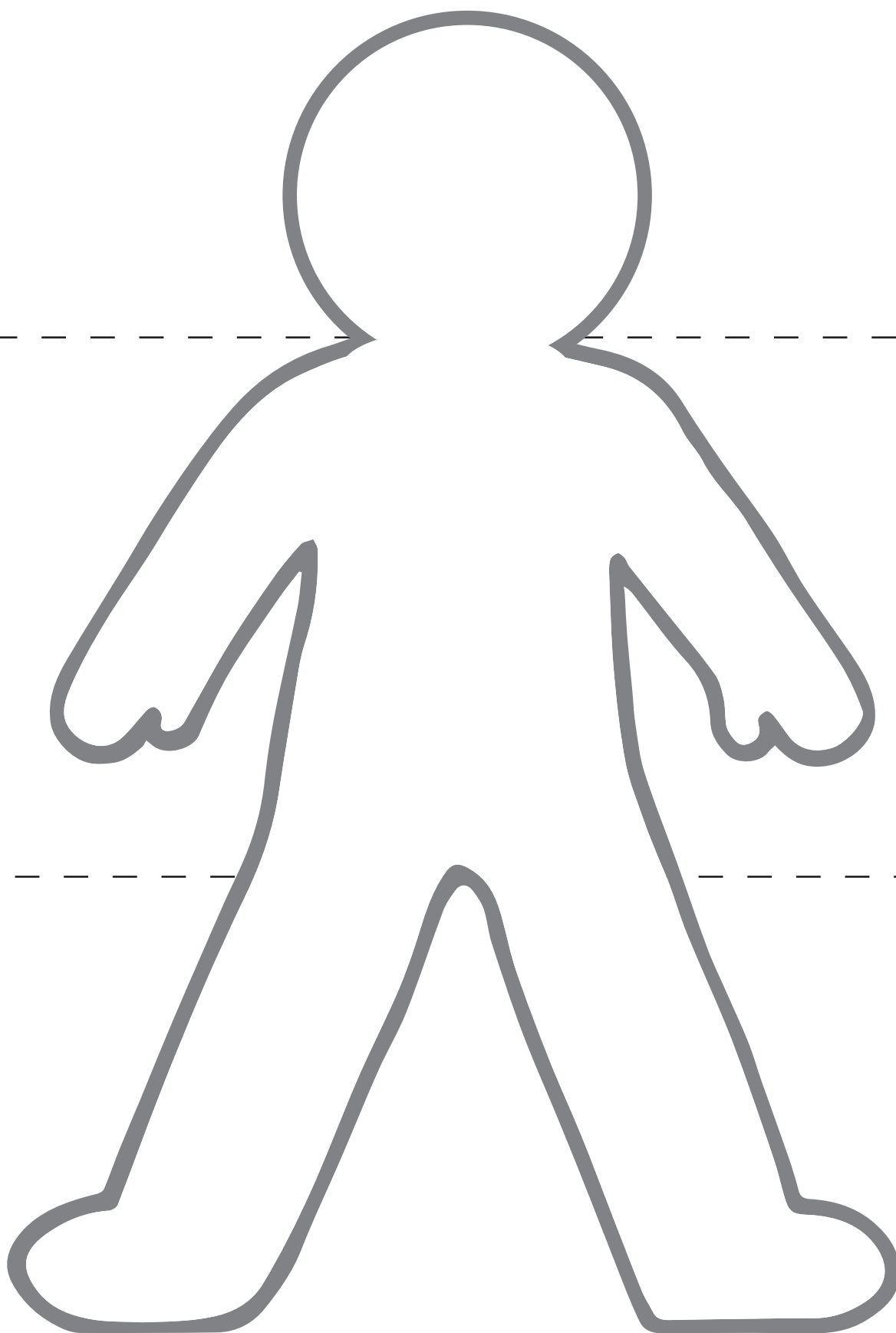
Second up:

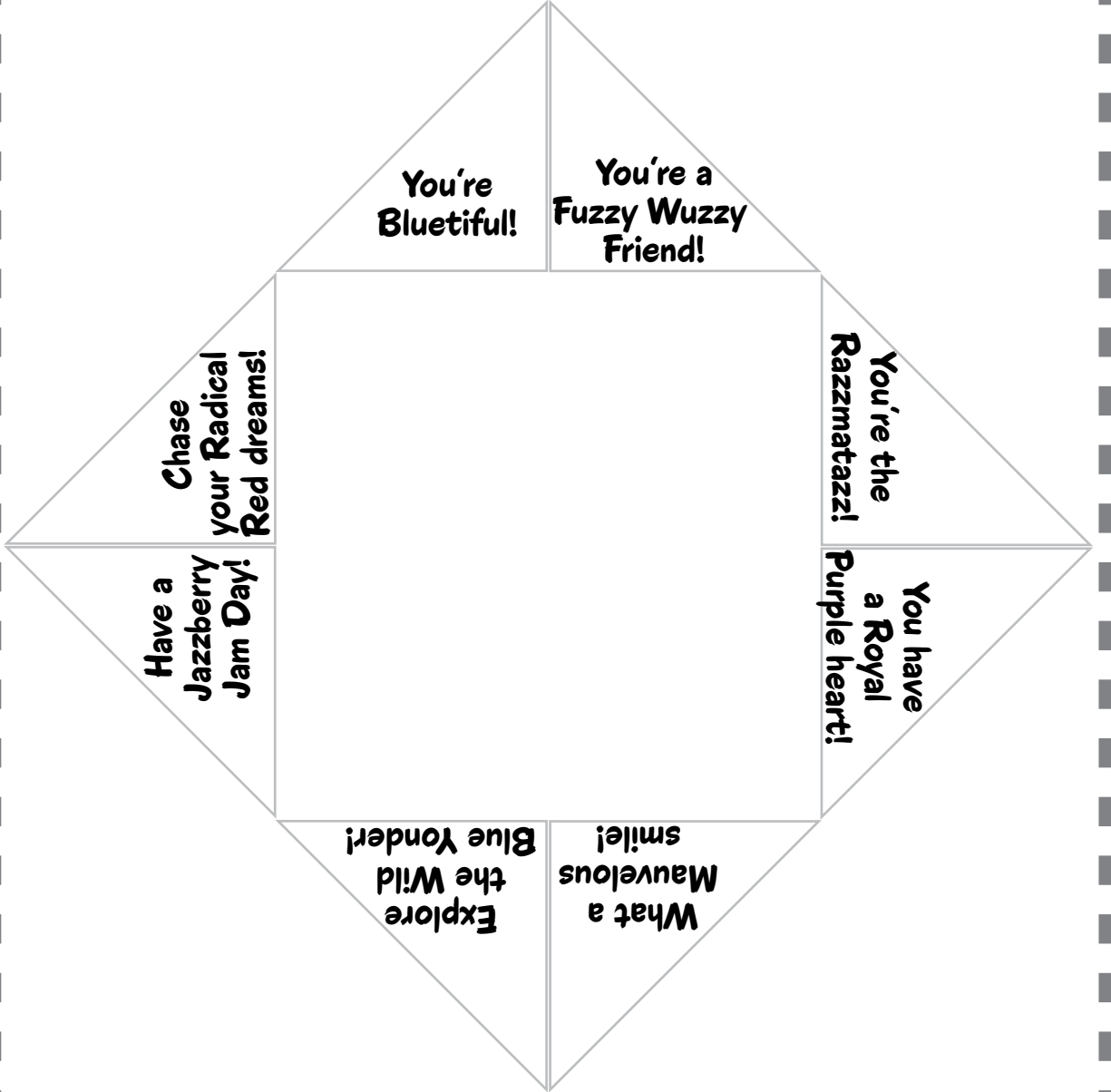
Decorate up to the line below!

Once you're done (don't peek before) unfold the paper to reveal your person!
Show your friends!

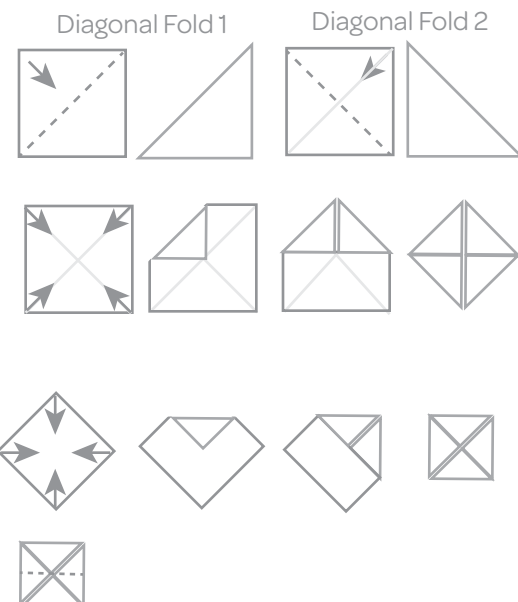






CONSTRUCTION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut along the dashed gray lines.
2. Flip so the text is facing down (so you can't see it).
3. Fold in half diagonally, bringing one corner to the opposite to make a triangle. Unfold, then do this in the other direction.
4. You'll see the center by where the folds met, now fold each corner over so it touches this point. Leave folded.
5. Flip the paper over, text-side facing up.
6. Fold each corner to the center, like you did in step 4.
7. Fold in half length-wise, decorate and you're done.

USING YOUR FORTUNE TELLER:

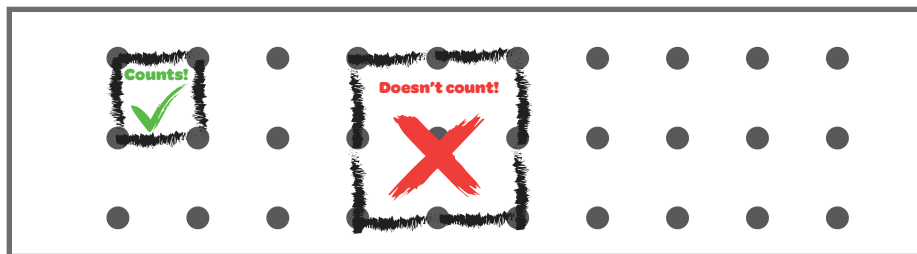
- Once you have your folded Fortune Teller, write a color (any color!) on each of the outer four outer flaps.
- Open those outer flaps to reveal each is split down the middle, forming a total of eight inner flaps. On each of those flaps, write a random number, don't repeat any!
- Hold the Fortune Teller with your fingers in the pockets. Have a person pick one of the colors on the outer four flaps. "Spell" out the color, pinching and pulling your fingers together - one motion for each letter (i.e. "blue" = 4 moves). Each move will reveal a set of 4 numbers from the inner flaps.
- Once you're done, have the person pick one of the numbers from one of the inner flaps. Pinch and pull for this many moves.
- Have the person pick a number from the set that's revealed now. This will be associated with their fortune. Unfold that flap and read the statement under the number they picked.



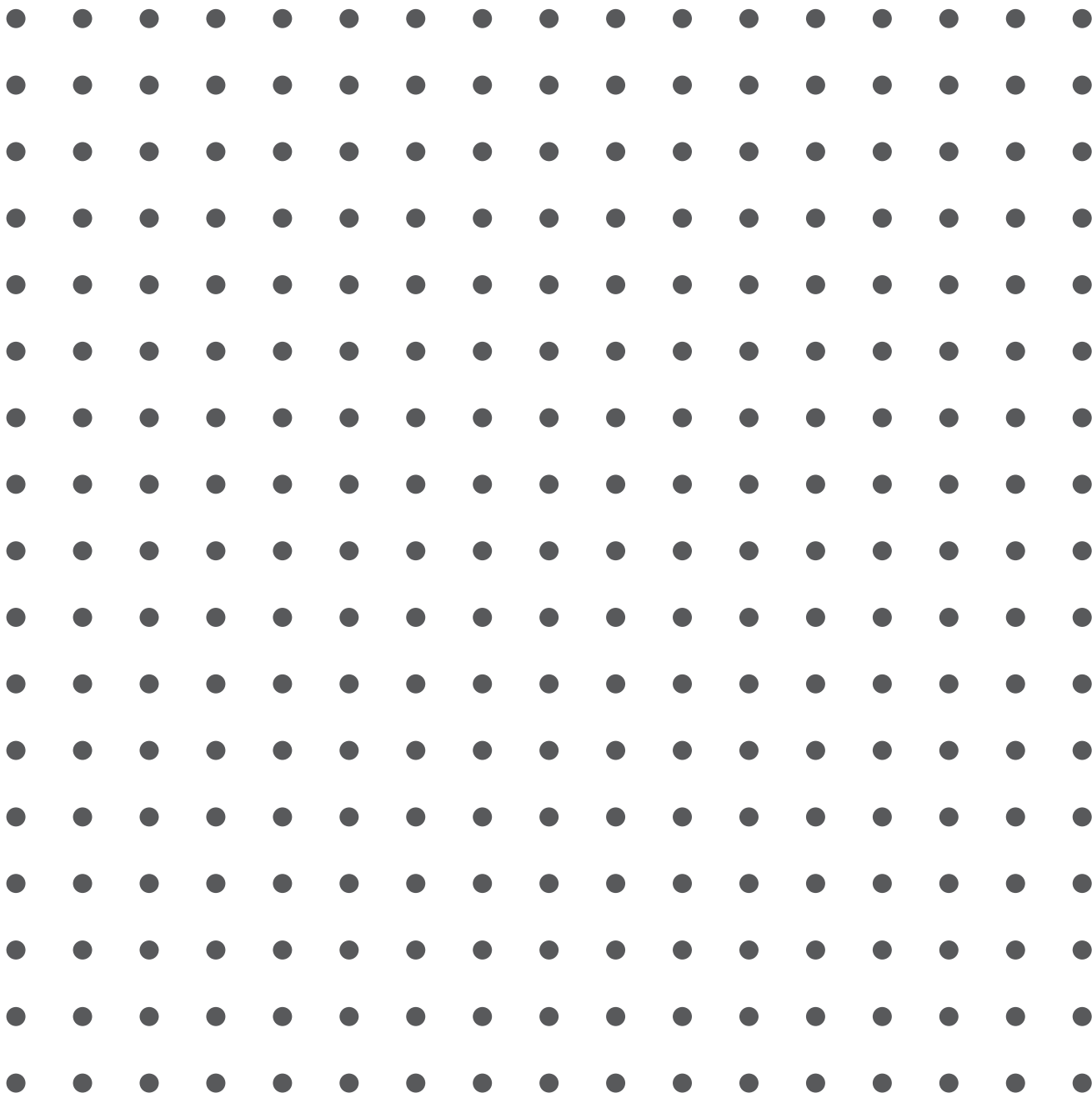

Your mission is to complete as many boxes as possible!

Take turns! Each turn, draw a line connecting two adjacent dots - you can connect dots horizontally or vertically (NOT diagonal). If you complete the fourth side of a box, write your initial in the box. Also, when you complete a box you get to make another move within your turn. NOTE: boxes only consist of 4 dots (2 dots high by 2 dots wide); any larger boxes (for example, 3 dots by 3 dots) don't count as completed boxes; example below:



The game ends when all 256 boxes have been made. The player with the most boxes wins!
